

INVESTMENT ATTRACTIVENESS: CONCESSION FORMAT

- 14 SPECIALIZED HEALTH RESORTS
 (SANATORIUMS) OF THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH
 (THE CARPATHIANS, ODESSA, KYIV AND LVIV
 REGION)
- THE TOTAL AREA OF 3 MILLION SQUARE METERS
- INVESTMENT SIZE FOR EACH OBJECT: \$8-19 MILLION

THE STATE

- Transfers the facility to the concession
- Expects the development of high-quality medical care
- Improvement of the investment climate

THE INVESTOR

- Receives land and premises in concession
- Provides free medical care to agreed number of patients
- Carries out profitable business activities
- Develop other activities on the territory (medical tourism, hotel services, etc.)

INVESTMENTATION ACTIVISTS: INFRASTRUCTURE PREFERMAT

Private operator is required to design, finance, construct and maintain the facilities, and the public sector uses the premises to deliver public services. The private investor is compensated through availability payments.

- NEW FORMAT OF HEALTH CARE FACILITIES FOR UKRAINE
- CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW ONES AND COMPLEX RENOVATION \$225 MILLION

GENERAL HOSPITALS

- 280 GENERAL HOSPITALS PROVIDE MEDICAL CARE IN REMOTE AREAS IN 6 BASIC AREAS OF SERVICE AT THE COMMUNITY LEVEL: THERAPY, SURGERY, TRAUMATOLOGY, INTENSIVE CARE, AND INFECTIOUS DISEASES
- CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLEX RENOVATION \$5 BILLION

CLUSTER HOSPITALS

- CONSTRUCTION OF ≈100 NEW HOSPITALS BASED ON THE PRINCIPLE OF "BETTER THAN BEFORE"
- PRIORITY FOR THE 10 MOST AFFECTED REGIONS
- CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLEX RENOVATION \$5 BILLION

WHAT CAN THE SYSTEM PROVIDE TO THE ECONOMY OF UKRAINE?



PHARMACEUTICAL INDUSTRY

- Production of drug products in all therapeutic groups and in all dosage forms on the basis of Ukrainian manufacturers
- \$2.5-3 billion/year market volume
- \$1 billion of euro investments in new developments
- Three-fold growth of export to >\$1 billion/year

CLINICAL TRIALS

- Experience in implementation
- High level of training of research doctors
- Willingness to conduct clinical trials that left the Russian Federation
- Goal: 10% of the EU market, \$3 billion/year

MEDICAL TOURISM

- Dentistry, cardiology, oncology, diagnostics, rehabilitation, surgery, joint replacement, cosmetic surgery
- Availability and absence of queues
- Five-fold growth of the industry
- \$840 million/year market volume
- 300 thousand patients (tourists) per year

HEALTH TECH

- High personnel potential and experience in project implementation
- Ten-fold
- Growth of the industry
- \$1.2 billion/year market volume

MEDICAL education

- \$5,000 million/year provision of educational services
- Development of the scientific component







RECOVERY OFFICE UNDER THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH
